Honoring: Our Mothers

We honor the mothers who have gone before us for their love, sacrifice, struggle and joy. Reaching: Social Evangelism

Evangelism is communication of the gospel in such a way that a person comes to know Jesus Christ as his or her personal Lord and savior. Implementing effective evangelism causes the believer to step out of the box and meet people where they are, be respectful, listen to the community, build trust and relationships, get the word out in a non-stigmatizing manner, offer service and information in a variety of locations and at non-traditional times, (especially after work hours). We do this for others because of what was done for us; and for what we have received! Acts 1:8 gives us this assignment: But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Receiving: Gods Spirit (Our Road to Pentecost)

Pentecost: means 50 – as mentioned in the Old Testament as well as the New Testament. We today celebrate 7 Sundays after Easter (observed on June 5); 50 days after the Resurrection, as we learned that's not **THE FINALE**. It signifies Gods spirit as it sits on his disciples. The Holy Spirit was introduced in the book of Acts of the Apostles 2:1-4; to ALL and there the church was given its decree......Go! The law was given, not on tablets of stone, but in our hearts. It is not the letter of the law, but the spirit of God in us that causes us to obey with excitement, joy, and commitment. 50 days Jesus connected with others. What will you do? Will this cause you to LEVEL UP?
