Welcome to Her-Story CLOTHED TO LEAD. CALLED TO DISCIPLE.

We proudly honor and celebrate Women's History Month at Greater Community Church of God in Christ—our unapologetically Blacknificent church where women are clothed in strength and dignity, and where their faith, leadership, and discipleship are cultivated and released with intention.

As we enter this season in 2026—what we boldly proclaim as HER-STORY—we do more than commemorate. We consecrate. We disciple. We deploy.

HER-STORY is holy ground. It is the living testimony of women who were clothed with strength and dignity and were not afraid of what was to come.
